What's happening?

We're replacing track at Jamaica Center and Sutphin Blvd-Archer Av that is at the end of its useful life.

What else should I know?

The subway is closed for disinfection from 1 AM to 5 AM nightly.

Check train destination signs and listen to on-train announcements.

New track will improve reliability and resilience so that we can provide better service.

We're doing this work now to prevent more disruptive emergency track work and unplanned service changes.

Since 2016, there have been 46 incidents between Jamaica-Van Wyck and Jamaica Center on the E line because of track conditions, resulting in 713 delayed trains.

Phase 1 of the project is expected to take six weeks, continuing to the early morning hours of Monday, November 2.

Phase 2 of the project, which will restore some **E** train service in the two-station project corridor, is scheduled to begin in early November and last until mid-December.

Weekends & Every Night after 9:30 PM

ignition will run between World Trade Center and Jamaica-Van Wyck, the last stop.

10 will still serve Sutphin Blvd-Archer Av and Jamaica Center.

Long Island Rail Road (LIRR) service will remain available at Jamaica Station.

In Queens

Consider using 3 stations on *Hillside Av* that will also be served by 3.

It's about a 10-minute walk to/from Archer Av.

Or, transfer free with MetroCard and use local buses to/from (3) (2) stations on nearby *Archer Av*.

Transfer between (a) and (b) trains at Kew Gardens-Union Tpke.

Free shuttle buses, Q54 and Q56, will run between Jamaica-Van Wyck and Jamaica Center, stopping at Sutphin Blvd-Archer Av.

To/from Manhattan

Consider **12** direct to/from Lower Manhattan, or via transfer with **A** or **B** at Broadway Junction.

Access to the JFK AirTrain Jamaica Station is still available via LIRR or 12. Customers can also take 15 to/from AirTrain at Howard Beach.

Cross-honoring on Long Island Rail Road Show your MetroCard to board at Jamaica, Kew Gardens, Forest Hills, Queens Village, Hollis, Rosedale, Laurelton, Locust Manor, St. Albans and Penn Station.
