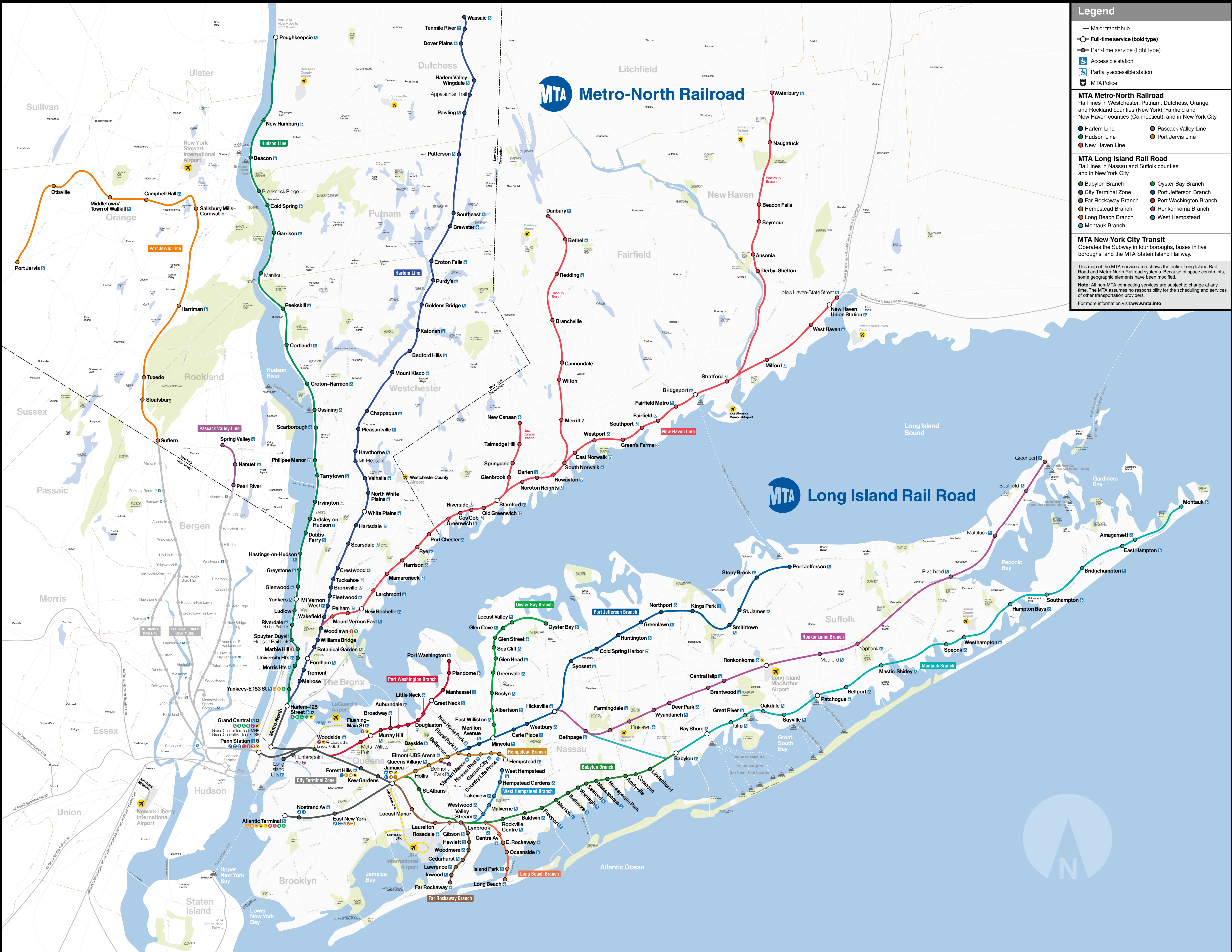


MTA Railroads
